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CLINICS for Future Symphonic Band Students:

We will be holding our annual Colorguard, Drumline and Front Ensemble clinics on May 17th, 19th and 24th prior to the auditions for these groups. In order to audition for these groups you must have already been accepted into the Symphonic Band. If you are interested in seeing what these groups are like, come to the clinics from 6:30-8:30pm in the band room. Feel free to come and try them out to see if you would like to be a part of any of these groups. The Colorguard will have auditions on the 24th. The drumline and front ensemble will have auditions after school on May 26th from 2:30-3:30pm.

If you play OBOE, BASSOON, BASS CLARINET, BARITONE SAXOPHONE, OR ANY PERCUSSION you MUST join one of these groups, or march a different instrument like flute, clarinet, or alto/tenor saxophone. Oboe, Bassoon, Bass Clarinet, and Bari Saxophone are *NOT* marched in marching band.

CANNON MUSIC CAMP IS BACK: June 25- July 16, 2022

Attending <u>Cannon Music Camp</u> held at the Hayes School of Music on the campus of **Appalachian State University** is a great way for students to connect, rejuvenate, and rekindle their excitement and passion for music, while infectiously bringing that energy back to your school music program!

- Cannon Music Camp is open to dedicated and inspired student musicians who are rising high school freshmen to rising college freshmen.
- Applications close three (3) days before the start of camp (June 22, 2022) or when quotas are reached in performing areas.

We are the premier comprehensive music camp in the Southeast. Cannon Music Camp is a magical three-week experience for students with intensive college preparatory work in performance and music theory. Plus, our campers *have fun* making music and socializing with like-minded musicians! Campers participate in daily ensemble rehearsals and music theory classes (as well as weekly masterclasses) in an atmosphere that elevates everyone's musicianship. Equally important is the direct instruction each camper receives in weekly, one-hour lessons. **We are currently enrolling students** for this summer's season! We have a limited amount of scholarship funds to distribute to individuals who want to participate in the process. Scholarships are awarded and reviewed until March 31st or when funds are depleted, whichever occurs first. Our average range is \$150-\$450. https://cannon.appstate.edu/scholarships

Note that submitting a performance, attending an audition site, or receiving a scholarship offer **DOES NOT SECURE** admission to Cannon. Students still need to **APPLY** through the application process to secure a space in their performance area for camp. Scholarship auditions/offers are conducted two ways:

- Submitting in a recording (see **Video Submission Process** https://cannon.appstate.edu/scholarships).
- Attend an onsite audition
- Receive an offer based upon selection to All-District, All-State, or Honors Ensembles

Multiple scholarship offers from Cannon Music Camp are possible; however, we regret students may take advantage of ONE OFFER, so please request to use the highest amount. Cannon Music Camp scholarship offers cannot be combined to create a larger scholarship.
