#### Intermediate Band

- Ensemble of about 60 students
- For ANY students that have NOT auditioned and have previous band experience
- There are <u>NO summer requirements</u> for Intermediate Band
- You must sign up for BOTH fall and spring semesters
- Music Performance Adjudication
- Frequent Guest Clinicians
- Day Trip Spring Trip this year was Carowinds



- Ensemble of about 70 students
- \*\*Audition Required\*\*
- There are **NO summer requirements** for Concert Band
- You must sign up for BOTH fall and spring semesters
- Has the option of Honors Credit
- Music Performance Adjudication
- Frequent Guest Clinicians
- Optional Spring Trip this coming year DISNEY WORLD

### Symphonic Band – Band Camp

- Band Camp is an additional cost for each Symphonic Band member.
  - First rehearsal is June 14 at 6:00!
- There are TWO weeks of Band Camp
  - 1st Week Pre-Band Camp at Leesville Road High School
    - 5-8:30 pm rehearsals (July 18-22)
    - Learn and practice marching techniques, rehearse the music for the show
  - 2nd Week Band Camp at Lees McRae College
    - July 25th-31st
    - Put Marching and Music TOGETHER! ③
- <u>The band camp fee must be paid by the second day of pre-band</u> <u>camp.</u>

### Additional Symphonic Band Requirements

- Additional Summer Rehearsals:
  - Aug. 16th, 17th, 18th, 23rd and 24th from 6-8:30pm
- Morning Rehearsals!
  - 6:45-7:15 am (Before School)
  - $\circ$  **<u>NOT</u>** All Year Round
- Sectional Once a Week After School or during Lunch
  - Cleared with all sports teams and coaches
- Home Football Games
- Marching Band Competitions usually 4 on Saturdays in September/October



- All Bands perform at least 3 concerts per school year
  - Winter Concert (December)
  - MPA Concert (March)
  - Spring Concert (May)
- All Bands perform for MPA adjudication at an area high school (March)
- There other performances, such as playing for Bands Club meetings, Senior Assembly, Graduation, and others that vary throughout the year.



#### • Symphonic Band ONLY (Marching Band Season)

- Performs at all home football games and some playoff games
- Marching Band competitions
  - 4 Saturdays in September-October (dates TBD)
- Raleigh Christmas Parade (mid-November)
- The bands are not complete and cannot perform to their potential if every member is not present. <u>Therefore, it is expected that as a member of a Leesville High School Band, your student will participate in all performances.</u>

### What is Fair Share?

- Fair Share is the amount of money assessed to each band member to cover the expected operating expenses for each band.
- The expenses included in fair share are items such as sheet music, instruments, competition fees, transportation expenses, and concert performance expenses. The cost of fair share varies each year.
- Symphonic Band fair share for 21/22 was \$250 Concert/Intermediate Band fair share for 21/22 was \$70.00
- We expect to communicate fair share costs for 22/23 when school begins in the fall.
- Fair share must be paid in full before your student is eligible to go on the spring trip.

### What does Fair Share pay for?

- Guest Clinicians on every instrument
- Hospitality
- Concert Production/Lighting
- Substitute Teachers
- Website Cost / Charms Cost
- Drill for Marching Season
- New Equipment
- UHaul Truck Rental
- Colorguard Fall and Winter
- Drumline Fall and Winter

- Buses/Transportation Costs
- New Instruments
- New Music
- School Instrument Repair/Cleaning
- Competition/Contest Registration Fees
- Instructor Fees guard/percussion
- Insurance
- Mailings
- Office Supplies
- Superior Plaques from MPA

#### Student Accounts

- An account used to track income and expenses for each band student
- Each student is assigned an account number
- Can check balance in Charms (charmsoffice.com)
- All payments are to be mailed to the Student Account Manager or put in the lock box at school.

## Spring Trips

- Each spring, the bands go on a trip.
- This trip will encompass a national band competition and some sightseeing and cultural experiences as well.
- A trip commitment form will be sent home in September/October. This should be returned promptly with a required deposit and required signatures. After paying the deposit, there are monthly payments due towards the trip that begin as soon as October/November. These payments cover festival fees, transportation, hotel, food, etc.
- Next school year we hope to take Concert and Symphonic Band to Disney and we hope to take a day trip with Intermediate Band to a theme park.
- Approximate Costs:
  - Symphonic Band/Concert Band 2020 trip (that was planned for Disney) was \$985
  - The day trip to Carowinds for Intermediate 2022 trip was \$150

### Fundraisers

#### • SCRIP and Grocery Cards

- $\circ$  All year long
- Percentage of cost of cards purchased
- <u>Credit to account-</u> monthly

#### • Venue Fundraising

- Performing Arts Center (PAC), Raleigh Convention Center (RCC)
   – all year long.
- Red Hat Amphitheater April October
- PNC Arena November-June (online course required to serve alcohol)
- \$15/hr; 4-6 hour shifts;
- <u>Credit to account</u> monthly

#### • Fruit/Flower Sales

- Students sell in October/November
- Deliver in early December
- Percentage of sales
- <u>Credit to account</u> late
   January/early February

#### • Luminary Sales

- Stonehenge and other neighborhood deliveries Thanksgiving weekend
- Students make and deliver kits in mid- December
- Profits divided among students who participated
- <u>Credit to account</u>-January



#### Symphonic Band

Issued a uniform during pre-band camp Coat, pants, hat, uniform bag Need to purchase: White **button-down** collar shirt White shoes - \$33 (purchase through the band)

#### **Concert/Intermediate Bands**

Purchase uniform through the band

Girls - dress - \$95 (new)

Boys – tuxedo - \$133 (new)

NOTES: You cannot use fundraised money to purchase uniform items. We usually have a used uniform sale in the fall!

### Charms Office Assistant

- Every student will have an account
  - Parents use the same account (i.e. if student changes the password, they need to share it with their parents)
- Parents/students update ALL contact information themselves
- All email & text communications come from Charms
- Login
  - School Code: Irhsbands
  - Password: student account number
  - Can change password once you sign in
