1. We are hosting!

Leesville Road High School Bands Club will host the ECDBA Middle School Music Performance Adjudication (MPA) on Monday and Tuesday, March 13-14, 2023. This year, 22 middle school bands from across Wake County will participate. Bands arrive throughout the day (8am – 3pm), dropping students off in the Middle School carpool loop and enter through the breezeway for registration. Students will then warm up in the dance room, move to the stage to perform, and then finish in the band room for sight-reading. Some bands may watch other bands in the auditorium before or after their scheduled performance. Three guest judges have been hired to adjudicate the event and they will be seated at the back of the auditorium recording their critique, plus an additional judge for Sight-Reading.

- d) **2023 Furman University/Greenville Jazz Collective Summer Jazz Camp:** Our directors received the following information about this summer camp opportunity for middle and high school students interested in Jazz performance:

2023 Furman University/Greenville Jazz Collective Summer Jazz Camp will be held at Furman University from June 25-29, 2023! The camp is designed for middle and high school students of all levels, and it will include instruction by the best jazz musicians in Upstate South Carolina. Students will perform in small and large jazz ensembles and receive instruction on improvisation, jazz history, jazz theory, and instrument-specific topics. Your students will return to school with a greater understanding of jazz theory, more refined improvisational skills, and a better sense of jazz style. We hope they'll be inspired to continue their study of this great music!

The camp is a partnership by Furman University and the Greenville Jazz Collective, a non-profit organization that has been raising the level of jazz performance and education since 2012.

Summer Jazz Camp runs from Sunday, June 25 to Thursday, June 29, with special clinicians' concerts every night at 7:30 PM and a final student concert at 4:30 PM on June 29th. All concerts are free and open to the public, and **rehearsals and masterclasses are open to all band directors**. The cost is \$530 for overnight campers and \$410 for commuters per student, but **the Greenville Jazz Collective is offering scholarships based on need. Registration for this camp opened on February 15th. We look forward to seeing your students in June!

1. Hot off the Press regarding the upcoming CB and SB Disney Trip:

Please read the following important announcement from the Disney Trip Planning Committee:

Hello parents, we have some Festival Disney trip updates:

1. We have elected to buy a 3-day ticket (one park per day) rather than 3-day park hopper passes. This is because all students must be at the same park at the same time and transitions among parks would take valuable time out of our fun day. We were able to reallocate that cost savings to cover another increase in the Genie Plus service fees and to add some extra money (approximately \$5 per day) to their daily meal gift cards for a beverage, sweet treat or snack.

Students are still welcome to bring additional personal money to put towards extra snacks and souvenirs.

RaiseRight: Angela Hamilton

Updated Info on the Scrip/RaiseRight gift card program: Please Note: This program is a "Digital Gift Card" system. No physical cards will be supplied. Once purchased, families can access all of their gift cards in the RaiseRight app at any time. RaiseRight works similarly to the Grocery Cards. The major differences are: 1.) The cards are ordered ahead of time and delivered about 2 weeks after orders are taken. 2.) RaiseRight includes, but is not limited to, local stores. Some stores include Sears, Gap, Pottery Barn and some restaurants include Little Caesar's, Red Robin, Chili's. A complete list of stores and more details about the program can be found on the company's website at raiseright.com. Some cards are reloadable at the stores, but to get the rebate you must purchase a new one each time from the Band's Club.
