Poster guidelines:

- 1. Standard size poster (22x28...+/-) in portrait format (short end on top and bottom)
- 2. Poster board colors should be either white, green, navy, silver, or gold.
- 3. If interested you can laminate your poster but since it will be displayed indoors is not necessary (this is suggested)

Senior parents if interested, create a senior poster for your student! These posters usually include one or more photos, such as their senior photo, along with their name and some embellishments.
