Guidelines and judging criteria are included with the application. Judges are professionals in their field.

Recognition:

- > 1st place in each category receives a cash award of \$75.00.
- > 2nd place in each category receives a cash award of \$50.00.
- > All contestants receive a Certificate for their participation.
- Overall winner receives an additional cash award of \$150 and is invited to perform at the Arts Festival Open House on January 29th at the Woman's Club of Raleigh venue between 4pm and 7pm.
- 1st and 2nd place winners move on to District VI Music Contest on Saturday, February 10, 2024, at First Baptist Church, 99 N. Salisbury Street, in downtown Raleigh. The contestants need to arrive by 9:00a.m. Registration and lunch for student awardees will be provided by The Woman's Club of Raleigh. Transportation may also be provided, when needed.
